Key Responsibilities and Duties

SAFETY:

- A crucial aspect of this job is quality control, as you must inspect both raw materials and finished products for compliance with safety and company standards.
- Work to the required standards with minimal supervision.
- Ability to carry out self-inspection of own welding activities within defined parameters/requirements before submitting work to final inspection.
- Undertake good housekeeping to reinstate the work area following engineering activities
- Work safely ensuring work areas are free from hazards and equipment is visually inspected before use
